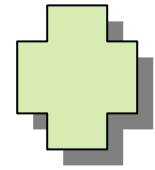

The children did a wonderful job with their first reading groups last week. Please make sure that they read their book to you when they bring it home. Make sure to store the books in a safe place so that they can re-read them to you at a later time. Keep reinforcing the skills they are learning- I am so proud of them! The reading groups will begin again after Christmas.

Listed below are areas to reinforce at home:

Bible: We will talk about *Kings Worship Jesus* (Matt. 2:1-12). The Bible memory verse will be the letter O.

Phonics: We will introduce the letter Vv and the Vv blends. We will also continue to practice the blends and vowel sounds we have already learned. Please take a few minutes over the holidays to read to the children and fill it out in their reading logs- it will make a difference believe me! Please look for words that begin with Vv for our word wall.

Math: We will introduce the number 11 review all numbers 1-10. The children will continue to practice calendar concepts, counting by 1's and 10's and estimation.

Language Development: We will talk about insects, ants, butterflies and ladybugs.

Book of the Month: *The Christmas Story.*

Project Respect Skill of the Week: Saying Thank you.
